

PRIVACY NOTICE for Employees, Volunteers, Board and Committee Members

1. Introduction

We are Mayo, Sligo and Leitrim Education and Training Board, MSLETB. MSLETB provides primary level education, secondary level education, second chance education; further education and training including apprenticeships; Youthwork, community-based education programmes; outdoor education; outreach programmes, specialist programmes, for example, through Music Generation and other programmes/courses as may be delivered/funded/sponsored in whole or part or in co-operation with other bodies/agencies and so forth.

MSLETB is the data controller of your personal data and is subject to the Data Protection Acts 1988 to 2018 (“DPA”) and the General Data Protection Regulations (the “GDPR”). The GDPR and the DPA confer rights on individuals regarding their personal data, as well as imposing responsibilities on persons processing personal data, in this case the ETB. 2. Why we collect and process your personal data

This Privacy Notice outlines the main elements of MSLETB’s Data Processing Policy that relate to the personal data collected and processed by MSLETB in relation to its Employees, Volunteers, Board and Committee Members. This notice also applies to those engaged in processing personal data for administrative requirements and/or to fulfil contractual and legal obligations.

3. The personal data we collect and process

The types of personal data we collect about you may include the following:

Identity	Name, surname, date of birth (DOB), PPSN, gender, marital status, any information which may be provided on documents proving the foregoing, <i>e.g.</i> driving license number or passport number.
Contact Information	Address including Eircode, email address, phone number, emergency contact details.
Employment	Job title and positions, job description, pay scale and scale point, previous employment details and experience, start and end

	dates of employment, interview assessment, marking and correspondence, record of previous service including correspondence with previous employers, details of training and professional development, probation information, promotions and progress information, resignation letters.
Recruitment	Recruitment information, details of qualification, any professional development courses, any other information given on application forms, references and other information that is part of the application process and appointment process, application forms and CVs.
Financial Details	Bank details, tax and PRSI details.
Teaching Details	Teacher Number, Teaching Council registration information, registration with any other professional or accreditation body
Garda Vetting	Garda vetting application number and vetting outcome.
Leave and Service	Applications for statutory leave, documentation of authorisation for non-statutory payroll deduction, salary claim forms and adjustments.
Superannuation	Superannuation calculations, pension schemes, pension contributions, final pensions benefit calculations, service history, pension adjustment and correspondence.
Images	Photographs, recorded images and CCTV footage.
IR/HR processes	Disciplinary and performance management records, correspondence and meeting records, files relating to hearings and recommendations, protected disclosures and related investigation files.
Internet Usage	MSLETB email address, MSLETB email address inbox and employee IT usage on employer's wifi and/or employer-provided devices.
Other	Pension details, IR/HR processes, immigration or work visa information and accident or injury reports.

Special categories of data are those revealing racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, or trade union membership, and the processing of genetic data, biometric data for the purpose of uniquely identifying a natural person, data concerning health or data concerning a natural person's sex-life or sexual orientation. Special categories of data are collected to monitor whether our equal opportunities policies are working and to carry out our obligations as an employer (if applicable). Non-statutory payroll deductions such as Trade Union Membership may be processed where employees have given authorisation to do so.

4. How we use your personal data

MSLETB processes your personal data for the purposes associated with the administration of the relationship between the employee/volunteer/Board/Committee Member and MSLETB and also fulfil contractual and legal obligations. We may use your personal data for the following purposes:

- running an efficient service
- complying with our obligations as an employer
- for recruitment and appointments
- allocating resources to our education centres
- monitoring the effectiveness of our equal opportunities policies
- to discharge our duties to other staff and students
- complying with our statutory reporting obligations to government bodies and EU funding bodies, and
- resolving disputes and defending litigation, among others.

Use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) - Microsoft Copilot and Copilot Chat

MSLETB uses Microsoft Copilot and Copilot Chat, AI-enabled productivity tools within Microsoft 365, to support staff with learning and administrative tasks by generating and summarising content from data they are authorised to access, subject to appropriate safeguards. Copilot does not use MSLETB data to train public AI models. Personal data is processed in accordance with GDPR, MSLETB policies, and Microsoft's contractual data protection obligations.

5. Legal bases for processing your personal data

The legal basis for MSLETB processing your personal data is that such processing is necessary for and connected with the performance of its statutory objects and functions, under the Education and Training Boards Act 2013, the Education Act 1998 and other relevant legislation and where processing is necessary for LCETB to perform a task in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in LCETB. 6. Third parties with whom we may share your personal data

Your personal data is held securely by MSLETB, and the processing of your personal data is restricted to MSLETB staff members who need your personal data to perform one of the purposes set out in [Section 2] of our Data Processing Policy. MSLETB will share your personal data, where necessary and relevant, with the following third parties:

Government Departments	Department of Education, Department of Social Protection, Department of Further and Higher Education, Research, Innovation and Science, Department of Children, Equality, Disability and Youth.
State of Regulatory Bodies	Revenue Commissioners, Comptroller and Auditor General, TUSLA, An Garda Síochána, HSE, Teaching Council, Health and Safety Authority.
Other	Trade Union (IR/HE issues), Occupational health advisors, Irish Public Bodies (ETB insurance providers), Banks/financial institutions (payment of wages), pension administrators and pension trustees, future employers (references), other providers including IT or cloud service providers, for example, Microsoft, security and legal advisors, Payroll Shared Services (ESBS), ETB Pension Paymaster, ETBI, Public Service Transfer Network, Interview Board Members.

Please note that the above is not an exhaustive list. However, if we share your personal data with any third party not listed above, this is only done where there is a legal basis and/or where we are legally required to. 7. Transfer of your personal data outside of the European Economic Area (EEA)

We do not transfer your personal data to a country outside the EEA. However, certain companies who process personal data on behalf of MSLETB may transfer personal data outside the EEA. This processing by certain companies will only be carried out in agreement with MSLETB and with the assurance that appropriate safeguarding measures, in line with those required under the GDPR, are in place to protect your personal data. We will inform you if your personal data is to be transferred outside the EEA.

8. Data Retention

We store your personal data for as long as is necessary according to MSLETB's Data Retention Schedule. For further information on retention periods, please go to [Section 6] of our Data Processing Policy available at www.msletb.ie.

9. Your Rights

Data Protection legislation provides you with the following rights:

- To complain to the Data Protection Commission.
- To receive a copy or access the personal data that MSLETB holds about you, together with other information about our processing of your personal data.
- To request that any inaccurate data that is held about you is corrected and incomplete data updated.
- To request that we erase your personal data.
- To request that we no longer process your personal data for specific purposes, or to object to our use of your personal data or the way in which we process it.
- To transfer your personal data to another organisation.
- To object to automated decision making or profiling.
